We are Brandy Barkley & Aubrie Britt, both stay-at-home, homeschooling moms, that started the Sprout Style Swap consignment sale to supplementing family income and providing an effective means of recycling like-new items to the greater Columbia area. While we started a children's consignment sale, we thought why not have an adult one as well! We strive to partner with you all in reclaiming the highest quality of gently used adult and household items to share with families in the community.

In these guidebook pages, you'll discover the essence of our enterprise, our values, our mission, and the commitment we hold towards excellence, sustainability, and customer satisfaction.

Every section is carefully crafted to offer insight into how we operate, our team's dedication, and the way we strive to make a positive impact. This handbook is a glimpse into our culture, a testament to the passion that fuels our endeavors.

How it Works

1. Collect

Please gather any gently used items you wish to sell from around your home. We're excited to help you consign these belongings and find them new homes.



2. Sort

Arrange your items by category and sizes, if applicable, to ensure a smooth and efficient consignment process.



3. Price

Use the software to price and tag your items reasonable prices (see pricing guide). Providing fair pricing will enhance the chances of successful sales.



4. Prep

Please ensure your items are clean, presentable, and in good condition before consigning them. Proper preparation will enhance their appeal.



5. Drop Off

Please drop off your prepared and priced items at our designated drop-off location during our business hours. Your timely contributions are essential for a smooth consignment process.



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1. The Basics

The Swap is excited to partner with you to sell your gently used adult clothing and household items. This is also a great time to swap out what you no longer need for new needs. In this handbook, you will find all the essentials you need to sell with us.

The Swap is open to the public. Anyone is welcome to sell! We accept gently used all season adult clothing, shoes, household and outdoor items, and more to resell.

- 4 Learn about local charities we support with donated items after the sale.

A \$15 selling fee is charged to help cover the cost of building rent. Sellers receive a pass to shop before the general public. Sellers price, tag & place their items out for sale, and then pick up (or donate) unsold items at the end of the sale. Sellers are NOT required to be onsite during the event.

****Checks will be mailed out at the end of sale. There will be a \$35 fee for any replacement checks to cover our bank fee to stop original check. We will not be able to reissue any checks 3 months after the end of the sale, October 16, 2026. ****



2. Registration

To become a consignor on our site, please follow these steps below or click the button below to watch a video.

How To Register

1. Go to www.Sproutstyleswap.com
2. Click on Adult Consignment Sale
3. Click on Sell, then "Register with us."
4. Create an account on the MyCM website by completing the registration process.
5. Select "The Swap Adult Consignment (year)" from the list of consignment options and proceed with the registration.
6. Make sure to pay the registration fee before moving forward. Note that PayPal payments may take up to 24 hours to process. If you do not have PayPal, please contact us for an alternate payment option.
7. Return to the merchant's site (myconsignmentmanager.com/sproutstyleswap) and use the login credentials you established earlier to access tagging services.
8. Verify your email address by clicking the confirmation link in the email sent by My Consignment Manager.
9. If you would like to Volunteer with us for an additional earnings as well as early shopping opportunities, look under Sprout Style Squad. Select a shift.
10. Navigate to the "Manage Items" section to initiate the tagging process for your items.



3. Earnings

Sellers receive 65% of the price they set for their items. If they volunteer, they get early access. Volunteering for additional shifts will earn the seller an extra percentage on sales along with early access! See our website for more information on volunteering. A \$15 fee is required upon registration. Your earnings will be paid to you at the end of the sale. There are no additional fees after the registration fee is paid.

4. Tagging Information

How To Tag

You will use the software to create, print, and tag all your items. Once all your items are tagged, see event schedule for drop off date. You will distribute your items on the sales floor. Then come shop at your early access time and sit back to wait for your earnings. See below for more information on drop off and tagging items.

5. Items Accepted and Not Accepted

We accept gently used household items. Items must be clean, in excellent condition, complete, and with working batteries. Please note that event volunteers are not available to assist with large items. Consigners are responsible for arranging their own help for the transportation and handling of these items during drop-off and pick-up. This is an all seasons event meaning we accept clothing, shoes, decor, etc. for all seasons. We DO NOT accept children's clothing and shoes as those are reserved for our children's consignment sales in the spring and fall.



Clothing - No Limits

We accept adult clothing that is clean, current in style, and in like-new or gently used condition. All clothing must be free from stains, tears, excessive wear, odors, pet hair, and missing buttons or broken zippers. Items should be appropriate for resale and reflect current trends.

Clothing is organized and limited by category within each size.

Tops

- Short-sleeve shirts
- Long-sleeve shirts
- Tanks and camisoles
- T-shirts
- Blouses

- Jeans
- Pants and slacks

Clothing - No Limits

Outerwear

- Blazers
- Cardigans
- Jackets
- Vests
- Coats
- Heavy coats are accepted but tend to sell best when priced lower

Activewear

- Athletic tops
- Athletic bottoms (shorts, leggings, pants)
- Sweatshirts and hoodies

Sleepwear & Loungewear

- Pajama and lounge sets
- Nightgowns
- Robes

Specialty Clothing

- Swimwear (bathing suits and swim cover-ups)
- Maternity clothing
- Nursing tops
- Holiday and seasonal wear

All clothing must be hung on appropriate hangers and sorted by size and category. Items that do not meet these guidelines may be declined at check-in.

NOT ACCEPTING Basic Editions, Temu, Shein, Alfred Dunner, Merona as well as any brands not in existence in last 3 years.



Accessories – No Limits

We accept adult accessories that are clean, functional, and in like-new or gently used condition. Items must be current in style and free from excessive wear, stains, odors, or damage.

We accept the following items:

- Accessories
- Handbags and purses
- Wallets and wristlets
- Belts
- Scarves and wraps
- Hats and caps
- Sunglasses (lenses must be scratch-free)

Jewelry

- Fashion jewelry
- Watches (must be in working condition or have a new battery)

Cold-Weather Accessories

- Gloves and mittens
- Beanies and winter hats

Condition Requirements

- Zippers, snaps, clasps, and straps must be fully functional
- No peeling, cracking, or excessive wear
- Jewelry must be free from broken clasps or missing stones



Shoes – No Limits

We accept shoes in 'like new' or gently used condition, covering all brands. We accept adult shoe sizes 5 and up only. Adult cleats are allowed, as well as adult roller skates (size 4+), which should be placed in the sporting goods section by gender and size.

NOT ACCEPTING shoes with toe wear, dry-rot soles, or little tread remaining. Any shoes showing these signs of wear will be removed from the sale.



Books – No Limits

We accept adult books in good to like-new condition only. Books must be clean, intact, and free from excessive wear, stains, odors, writing, or missing pages.

We accept books in the following categories:

- Homeschool & Parenting
- Fiction
- Non-Fiction
- Home, Food, & Lifestyle

NOT ACCEPTING Romance Novels and books with suggestive or inappropriate covers.



DVDs & Gaming – No Limits

- DVDs rated R or above are not accepted
- All DVDs must be priced at \$2 or less per DVD, unless part of a set
- DVD sets may be priced at \$2 per DVD in the set or less
- Cases must be included and free from excessive damage
- Video games (discs or cartridges must be clean and fully functional)
- Gaming chairs
- Gaming setups and accessories (controllers, headsets, charging docks, stands, and similar items)
- Items that are damaged, incomplete, or do not meet these guidelines may be declined at check-in.



Furniture – No Limits

We accept furniture and large home items that are clean, fully functional, and in like-new or gently used condition only. All items must be current in style and comparable to what is still available in retail stores. All large furniture will need a 'large item claim ticket'.

We accept the following items:

- Dressers with minimal surface wear (no deep scratches, chips, or damage)
- Bed frames and bedding (Full/Double, Queen, and King sizes only)
- Like-new or gently used sectionals and other upholstered furniture (must be clean, odor-free, and free of stains, tears, pet hair, or structural issues)
- Rugs (must be clean and rolled for drop-off)
- Decor pillows (no stains, odors, peeling, or excessive wear)
- Curtains (must be tagged with length × width and number of panels; hang on a hanger)
- New-with-tags curtains in original packaging may be placed in a bin near hanging curtains
- Tablecloths (dimensions must be clearly marked on the tag)
- Lighting & Wall Decor
- Lamps and lampshades
- Chandeliers (fully intact and ready to hang)
- Mirrors (current styles only)
- Vases
- Pictures and picture frames with glass or plastic fronts (current styles only)



Furniture – No Limits

- Home décor items that are current in style and still available in retail stores
- Wreaths
- Travel & Storage
- Adult luggage, duffle bags, and overnight bags (current styles only)
- Exercise equipment (must be fully functional)
- Camping equipment, including tents (may remain in original bags) and camping chairs
- Garden décor, planters, and garden equipment (must be clean and free of rust)

Condition Requirements:

- All furniture must be structurally sound, clean, and ready for resale
- No vintage, hand-painted, or refinished items
- No cracks, missing shelves, missing cane, broken glass, or incomplete pieces
- Upholstered items must have no holes, stains, odors, or pet hair
- Items requiring assembly must include all hardware and bolts

Furniture or large items that do not meet these guidelines may be declined. A \$10 disposal fee will be deducted from your check for any large, unusable items left for us to remove.



Musical Instruments – No Limits

We accept musical instruments and related equipment that are clean, complete, and fully functional. All items must be appropriate for adult use and in like-new or gently used condition.

We accept the following items:

- Instruments
- Acoustic and electric guitars
- Bass guitars
- Keyboards and digital pianos
- Violins, violas, and cellos
- Wind and brass instruments (e.g., flutes, clarinets, saxophones, trumpets, trombones)
- Percussion instruments (e.g., drums, practice pads, hand percussion)
- Accessories & Equipment
- Instrument cases and gig bags
- Guitar stands, straps, tuners, and capos
- Amplifiers (fully functional; no buzzing or distortion)
- Music stands
- Pedals and small audio accessories

Condition Requirements

- Instruments must be playable and in working order
- No cracked wood, broken keys, warped necks, or major cosmetic damage
- Brass and wind instruments must be clean and free of excessive dents or corrosion
- Electronic instruments and accessories must power on and function properly
- All necessary components (keys, mouthpieces (clean & sanitized), cords, pedals, hardware) must be included
- Items that are damaged, incomplete, non-functional, or require repair will not be accepted.



Outdoor & Lawn Equipment – No Limits

We accept outdoor and lawn equipment that is clean, safe, and fully functional. All items must be appropriate for residential use and in like-new or gently used condition. Battery-powered and electric items must be tested, in working order, and include the required battery and/or charging cord.

We accept the following items:

Handtools

- Rakes (leaf and garden)
- Shovels and spades
- Hoes
- Trowels
- Cultivators
- Hand weeder
- Pruning shears
- Loppers
- Manual hedge clippers
- Garden forks
- Post hole diggers

Watering & Irrigation

- Garden hoses
- Hose reels
- Sprinklers
- Watering cans
- Drip irrigation kits
- Timers and basic irrigation accessories



Outdoor & Lawn Equipment - No Limits

Electric & Battery-Powered Equipment

- String trimmers
- Edgers
- Leaf blowers
- Hedge trimmers
- Chainsaws (electric or battery-powered only)
- Small pressure washers (electric only)

Outdoor Living & Yard Items

- Garden carts and wheelbarrows (clean and rust-free)
- Planters and pots (clean and rust-free)
- Garden décor
- Outdoor storage bins
- Fire pits (clean and safe for use)
- Lawn Mowers
- Push Mowers

Condition Requirements

- Tools must be clean and free of excessive rust
- All powered equipment must be fully operational and tagged as working
- Batteries must be included where applicable
- Items must be safe, complete, and ready for immediate use

Not Accepted

- Large trailers or tow-behind equipment
- Chemicals, fertilizers, or pesticides
- Broken, incomplete, or non-working items



Sporting Goods – No Limits

We accept sports and exercise equipment that is clean, safe, and fully functional. All items must be appropriate for adult use and in like-new or gently used condition. Equipment should be complete, with no missing or broken parts.

We accept items for the following sports and activities:

Sports Equipment

- Tennis equipment (racquets, balls, bags, nets)
- Pickleball equipment (paddles, balls, nets)
- Basketballs and basketball accessories
- Softball and baseball equipment (bats, gloves, balls, helmets, bags)
- Biking equipment (adult bicycles, helmets, pumps, bike racks, accessories)
- Soccer equipment
- Golf equipment (clubs, bags, balls, training aids)
- Fitness and recreational sports gear for adults

Exercise & Fitness Equipment

- Free weights (dumbbells, kettlebells, weight plates)
- Weight benches
- Resistance bands and suspension trainers
- Yoga and Pilates equipment (mats, blocks, straps, foam rollers)
- Cardio equipment (fully functional only), including:
 - Treadmills
 - Stationary bikes
 - Ellipticals
 - Rowing machines



Sporting Goods – No Limits

Condition Requirements

- Equipment must be fully functional and safe for use
- No broken frames, cracked plastic, frayed straps, or missing hardware
- Bikes must have working brakes and tires in usable condition
- Large exercise equipment must power on and operate properly

Not Accepted

- Broken, incomplete, or unsafe equipment
- Items requiring repair or replacement parts
- Heavily worn or damaged gear

Houseware Items – No Limits

We accept the following items:

Tabletop & Serving

- Silverware (complete matching sets only)
- Dishes (sets of 4 or more only; like-new or gently used with no chips, cracks, scratches, or stains)
- Glassware (matching sets only; like-new or gently used)

We recommend placing glassware in a box with the lid removed, wrapped securely, and taped as needed

Kitchen Organization & Storage

- Kitchen pantry and drawer organizers
- Dividers and storage containers
- Disposable food containers (new and in original packaging only)

Kitchen Tools & Cookware

- Cutting boards and cheese boards (new only)
- Pots and pans (no scratches, peeling, or wear on nonstick/Teflon surfaces)
- Kitchen utensils (rolling pins, large spoons, ladles, knives, knife blocks, and similar items)



Houseware Items – No Limits

Cleaning & Household

- Cleaning products (sealed only)
- Garbage cans (new only)
- Vacuums (canister emptied, filters and rollers clean)

Home Fragrance

- Candles and Scentsy wax (new only)

Appliances

- Small appliances (must be clean inside and out and fully functional)
- Large appliances, including:
 - Stoves
 - Refrigerators
 - Microwaves
 - Dishwashers
 - Washers and dryers

(Large appliances must be cleaned thoroughly inside and out and fully operational.)

A \$15 disposal fee will be deducted from your check for any unusable or non-working appliances left for us to remove.

Office & Paper Goods

- Office supplies (like-new condition, with or without original packaging)
- Gift wrap and stationery

Items that do not meet these guidelines may be declined at check-in.



Pet Care – No Limits

We accept pet-related items that are clean, safe, and in like-new or gently used condition. All items must be free from pet hair, odors, stains, or visible wear.

We accept the following items:

- Pet Gear & Supplies
- Pet cages and carriers
- Dog kennels
- Fish tanks and aquariums (glass intact; no cracks or leaks)
- Larger pet items suitable for resale

Pet Accessories

- Food and water bowls
- Leashes, collars, and harnesses
- Beds and mats (clean and odor-free)

Pet Clothing

- Pet clothing (must be clean and placed on hangers)

Items that are damaged, heavily worn, or do not meet these guidelines may be declined.



Crafts & Games – No Limits

We accept craft items that are clean, complete, and in like-new or gently used condition. Supplies should be organized, usable, and appropriate for resale.

Craft Supplies

- Scrapbooking supplies (paper, stickers, albums, tools)
- Yarn, fabric, and sewing notions (clean and free from odors or damage)
- Beads, jewelry-making supplies, and findings
- Painting and drawing supplies (paints must be sealed)
- Stamps, inks, and stencils
- Craft kits (must be complete)

Tools & Equipment

- Cutting tools and paper trimmers
- Die-cutting machines and accessories
- Sewing machines and small craft machines (must be fully functional)

Finished Craft Items

- Handmade décor items in current styles
- Seasonal craft décor

Games

- Board games (all pieces, cards, and instructions must be included)
- Card games (complete decks only)

Puzzles

- Puzzles must be secured or labeled as complete

Condition Requirements

- Items must be clean, complete, and usable
- No broken tools, or incomplete kits
- Sewing machines and electronic tools must power on and function properly



6. Quality Standards

At Sprout Style Swap, while we strive to maintain general quality standards, we do not individually inspect each item. Our primary function is to facilitate a marketplace for sellers and buyers. However, we reserve the right to remove items that fail to meet our basic quality requirements.

- ⚠️ **Safety Guidelines:** We may offer safety tips to participants, but it is ultimately the seller's responsibility to ensure the safety of the items sold and purchased.
- 👤 **Hanger Guidelines:** Metal hangers are preferred, but plastic hangers are also acceptable. Choose hangers that are proportional to the size of the clothing, use toddler-sized hangers for smaller children's clothes.
 - Adult hangers can be obtained for free or at a low cost from most dry cleaners and large box stores such as Kohls or Old Navy.
 - Orient the hanger so that the opening faces left like a question mark.
- ✅ **Preparing Your Items:**
 - Refer to the 'Items Accepted' list.
 - Check if your equipment is on the recall list provided. Recalled items are not accepted.
 - We only accept items that are of high quality, clean, and current. Scrutinize each item as if you were the buyer.
 - Inspect for stains, holes, missing parts, etc., as these disqualify items.
 - Clean baby equipment thoroughly, including washing fabric covers of car seats and strollers, to increase the likelihood of sale.
 - Utilize a magic eraser for tough marks.
 - Lestoil and Dawn dish detergent are excellent for removing grease stains.
 - Lysol wipes are great for cleaning toys and equipment.
 - Freshly laundered and ironed items are more likely to sell.



1. Supplies Needed

For organizing and tagging items, the following supplies are needed:

- Zip ties, also known as cable ties.
- Cardstock (65lb):
 - Colored (pastel or neon shades, light colors only): For items that sellers wish to retrieve if unsold.
 - White Card Stock Paper: Specifically for items to be donated to charity.
- Scissors for cutting tags and preparing items.
- An ink pen for labeling or writing on tags.
- A hole punch for attaching tags to items.
- Painter's tape for securing items with delicate covers.
- Quart, gallon, and/or 2 gallon size plastic bags: To package shoes and small, loose items.
- Packing tape for securely closing bags and attaching tags.

Note: Please avoid using dark-colored card stock, as it interferes with scanning processes. Additionally, refrain from using beige or cream colors, which could be mistaken for the white donation tags. Do not cover the barcode when tapping your card or item, as this will prevent it from being scanned properly at checkout.

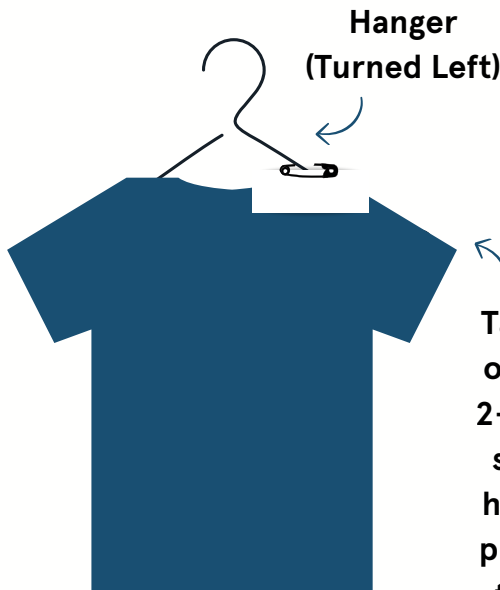
To prevent holes in fabric, avoid using safety pins on delicate materials and attach tags to seams or sturdy areas. Double-check for small snags or tears before consigning, as damaged items may not be accepted.



1. Prep + Tag

Ensure your tagged clothing appears like this:

Shirts

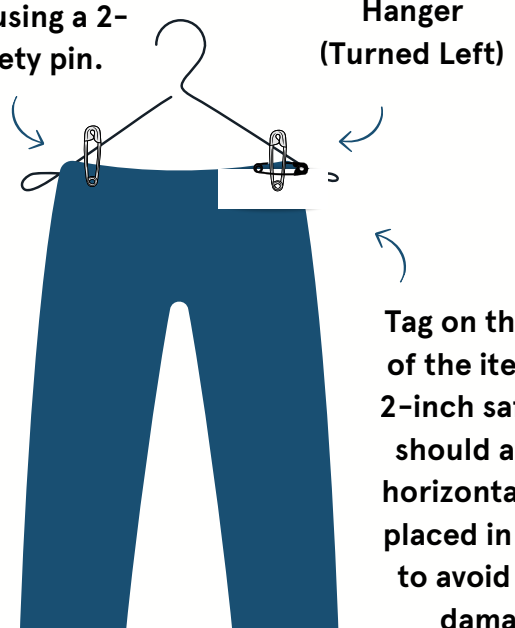


Hanger
(Turned Left)

Tag on the right of the item. The 2-inch safety pin should appear horizontally and placed in a seam to avoid fabric damage.

Pants

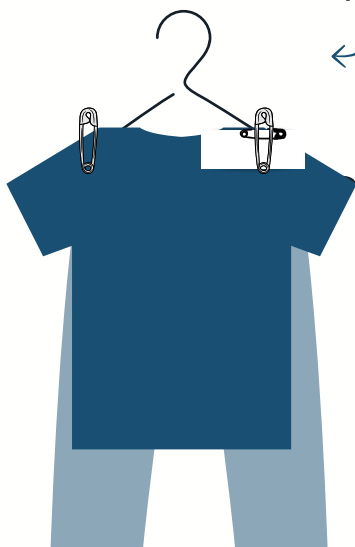
Pin pants to hangers using a 2-inch safety pin.

(Turned Left)

Tag on the right of the item. The 2-inch safety pin should appear horizontally and placed in a seam to avoid fabric damage.

Clothing sets, 1 hanger

Please hang the shirt and pants back-to-back on one hanger using a 2-inch safety pin, ensuring both fronts are easily visible. Place pin in a seam to avoid fabric damage.

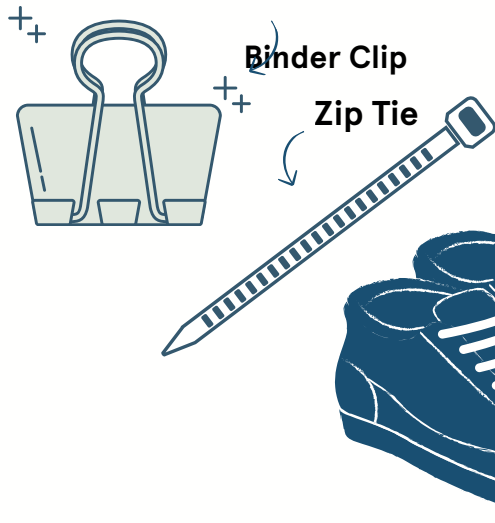
Hats

For hats, just like with any other item, use a zip tie to attach the tag if there's a label or suitable attachment point. If not, a safety pin is the next best option.



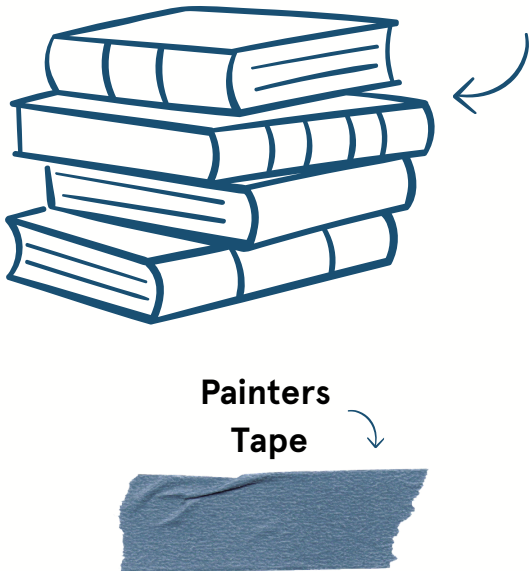


Ensure your tagged shoes appear like this:



Shoes should be fastened together by zip-tying the lace holes or attaching a binder clip to the ankle collar, ensuring the pair remains united.

Ensure your tagged books appear like this:



For attaching tags to books painter's tape is the ideal choice as it prevents tearing. Make sure to cover the item's original barcode with painter's tape, ensuring our system scans the barcode on your tag instead. Secure the tag on all four sides with the tape. When grouping multiple titles together, place them in a Ziploc bag, seal it with clear packing tape, and attach the tag to the bag, clearly listing each title in the tag's description.



Ensure your tagged games & puzzles appear like this:



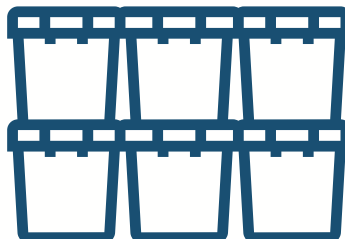
For attaching tags to games and puzzle boxes, painter's tape is the ideal choice as it prevents tearing. Before sealing boxed items, count the number of pieces and indicate "all pieces included" on the tag. For wooden puzzles, wrap them in plastic wrap before taping; this prevents tape from damaging the puzzle's surface. Use clear packing tape to seal the plastic wrap, ensuring it doesn't directly touch the puzzle. Alternatively, 2-gallon Ziploc bags are a great fit for puzzles and offer additional protection against damage.

Ensure your tagged items at drop off appear like this:

After placing tagged items on hangers we suggest arranging your items by size and gender to store in bins for drop off.





8. Prohibited Items

We maintain strict guidelines on the items we accept to ensure quality and safety.

The following items are not accepted:

- Recalled items.
- Items with stains, broken snaps, or zippers.
- Items missing parts or with broken parts.
- Handmade clothing or items.
- Items with markings, peeling stickers, or signs of excessive wear.
- Used undergarments.

Please ensure your items meet these criteria before submission.

As part of our commitment to safety, we require all consignors to ensure their items have not been recalled.

9. Pricing

Maximize your sales and declutter! Selling your items not only declutters your space but also brings in extra cash.

Here's a general pricing guideline: set your prices at about 1/4 to 1/3 of the item's original retail value. The exact price can vary based on the brand and condition of the item. Typically, items shouldn't be priced above 1/3 of the original cost unless they are brand new, unused, still in their original packaging, or have tags attached.

Consider offering a 50% discount on the last day of the sale. It's often better to sell items at sales price and clear out your space than to be left with unsold items. When creating your tags, opt out of the discount only for select items you prefer not to sell at a discount on the final day. If you're planning to donate any items that don't sell, and you're using white tags for them, definitely choose the discount option. Remember, the appeal of your pricing can depend on the brand and condition of each item.



Creating Outfits & Bundles

Bundling is encouraged for basics and lower-priced adult clothing items to help them sell more quickly and keep racks organized. Commonly bundled items include T-shirts, tank tops, camis, long-sleeve basics, leggings, athletic tops or bottoms, lounge and sleepwear pieces, maternity or nursing tops, holiday or seasonal tops, and swimwear paired with cover-ups. Bundles should consist of items that are the same size, similar in style, brand, and condition, and clearly tagged as a bundle with the total number of items listed. All items in a bundle must be securely attached together on one hanger when possible and priced at a clear value. Higher-value or fit-specific items such as jeans, dresses, blazers, coats, jackets, rompers, and jumpsuits should be sold individually rather than bundled.

Clothing Categories

Everyday / Value Brands

Includes items from widely available, budget-friendly brands commonly found at big-box or fast-fashion retailers. These items should be priced competitively and be current in style.

(Examples include brands similar to Old Navy, Target store brands, Amazon brands, Shein, and similar value-focused labels.)

Mid-Range Brands

This category includes brands known for consistent quality, everyday wear, and accessible pricing. These items typically hold value well when in excellent condition and on-trend.

(Examples include brands similar to Gap, Banana Republic, J.Crew, Loft, Ann Taylor, Madewell, Abercrombie, and comparable labels.)



Clothing Categories

Premium & Designer Brands

Includes well-known designer or premium brands recognized for higher-quality materials, tailoring, or brand recognition. Items should be in excellent condition and reflect current or classic styles that remain desirable.

(Examples include brands similar to Ralph Lauren, Tory Burch, Coach, Michael Kors, Free People, and comparable designers.)

Luxury & Boutique Brands

This category includes high-end designer and boutique brands with strong resale value. Items must be authentic, in excellent condition, and priced appropriately for the market.

(Examples include brands similar to Louis Vuitton, Gucci, Burberry, Chanel, and select boutique labels.)

Game Day & Fan Apparel

Show your team spirit with adult Game Day and fan gear. Accepted items include apparel representing local colleges and teams when in like-new or gently used condition.

10. Drop off Information

Here are important drop-off instructions for a smooth process:

1. Drop-Off Date and Time:

Please refer to the event schedule for the designated drop-off date and time. Consignors should arrive during their assigned time slot to help manage traffic flow and minimize wait times.

Plan for 45-60-minutes to drop off your items. Longer if you have 250+ items to drop off. Drive to Jamil Shrine Center, park, and check in.

2. Check-In Location:

Check-in will take place at Jamil Shrine Center, which will be clearly marked. Please follow the signage and directions provided to reach the check-in area.

3. Consignor Check-In:

Upon arrival at the check-in location, you will be greeted by our friendly volunteers or staff members. Please have your name and seller number ready for verification.

4. Inspection and Sorting:

Your items will be inspected for compliance with our quality standards and guidelines. This step helps ensure that all items meet our event's quality criteria. Items that do not meet these standards may not be accepted.

5. Pricing and Tag Verification:

Our team will review your pricing and tags to ensure accuracy. Please make sure that your tags are securely attached to each item and contain all necessary information, including the item's description, price, and your seller ID.



6. Item Placement:

You will place your clothing on the racks by size, gender, and category when you arrive. The more organized you are, the easier drop off will be! You will place non-clothing items in appropriate categories on the sale floor. For your large items, ensure your large item claim ticket is attached! If you need a large item claim ticket, we will have them available when you check-in at drop off.

7. Collecting Your Drop-Off Items:

Consignors can return to collect any unsold items during the designated pick-up hours (refer to the event schedule). Any items not collected during the designated pickup period will be donated or handled according to the event's policy. Double check to make sure you have your items and not someone else's.

8. Check Your Consignor Account:

After each sale day, you can log in to your consignor account to check your sales and track your earnings.

Items with white tags or those not picked up within the designated timeframe will be donated to charity. Sprout Style Swap does not retain donations for resale. We do not have a capacity to hold items for consignors that are not picked up during the pick up window, items left behind will be donated.
